The TKK steam trap has to be installed in a vertical position. Before installing the steam trap, isolate and depressurize the line. Please wait until the complete cooling of the system.

Carefully clean the upstream piping.

Fix by screwing or welding the steam trap following the direction of the arrow marked on the body: steam upstream and condensate downstream. For more information, please refer to NO1522 information sheet.

# **MOUNTING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS**

# **GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS**

The TKK42 is a thermostatic steam trap without non-return device dedicated to drain clean and sterile steam installation. It is recommended to install an isolating valve upstream from the steam trap.

#### MOUNTING

The TKK42 steam trap has to be installed in a vertical position with the arrow marked on the body pointing downwards.

Before installing the steam trap, isolate and depressurize the line. Please wait until the complete cooling of the system.

Clean carefully the upstream pipes.

Screw or weld the steam trap (depending on the connection type) following the direction of the arrow marked on the body: steam upstream and condensate downstream.

#### **DISMANTLING AND MAINTENANCE**

Remove the steam trap to proceed to its maintenance.

- 1. Shut the upstream isolating valve
- 2. Drain the downstream pipes
- 3. Make sure that there is no pressure and no temperature
- 4. Unscrew the steam trap, remove the strainer (mark 3), proceed to its cleaning and replace it if necessary
- Please check the capsule condition (mark 4), particularly check that there is no potential distortions. Replace the capsule if necessary. Remount the cap (mark 2)
